

## **Announcement From the Editor-in-Chief**

On behalf of the Circulation Journal, I would like to announce the following new changes of the Journal.

### **1. New Editorial policy to receive supplementary files**

We, Circulation Journal, will start to receive supplementary files from October 15 in addition to main document, table(s) and figure(s), with the aim to enhance the scientific level of the Journal. Up to 3 supplementary files will be received per manuscript, including video files. Please try to keep the total file size to 5 MB at the most. Please also note that all supplementary files undergo peer review, and they will be published only in the online journal after acceptance.

### **2. New full-color style of the Journal**

Circulation Journal will be a full-color journal from the issue of Vol. 74 No. 1. Therefore, the cost for colored figures will not be charged. Submission of manuscript with color figures is encouraged.

### **3. New Section of the Journal**

Based on the new changes mentioned above, we will start a new section of “**Images in Cardiovascular Medicine**”, where manuscripts reporting image(s) with high scientific impact will be published (usually 2 papers per issue).
